Contractors

The site safely handles large quantities of various hazardous chemicals and complies with all the necessary legislation and codes of practice.

All visitors must be accompanied or supervised by a member of Kersia staff at all times.

Access to the technical laboratory, process and warehousing is restricted.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be issued where required.

Vehicles & Pedestrians

The site speed limit is 10mph.

On arrival all visitors must ring the barrier intercom to contact reception to gain access to the site. Visitors should then park in a visitor parking space and then enter the reception area for further instructions.
