

Disposable Cloths



Operator to wear PVC or disposable apron and gloves when cleaning the machine. Wear eye protection when dosing chemicals.



THROUGHOUT THE DAY

- 1** Fill a clean bucket with water and add **2 x pushes** of **M2** Sanitiser.



- 2** After each use of the cloth, **rinse** thoroughly under running water to remove all traces of debris. Place the cloth to **soak** in the bucket of **M2** Sanitiser solution until next needed.



- 3** When cloth is needed, remove from the bucket of M2 Sanitiser solution and thoroughly rinse under running water.

Use cloth as normal, following Morrisons cleaning instructions.

Note: Do not use the M2 Sanitiser solution soaking bucket as cleaning solution, this is purely for storing and disinfecting the rinsed out cloths during the day.

If at any time during the day the soaking bucket looks to have a build up of debris present then empty contents down the mop cleaning station sink and make a fresh solution up following above instructions.

If at any time during the day the cloth becomes unusable or too damaged or uncleanable then it must be disposed of.



END OF THE DAY

- 1** Take cloth out of storage bucket and **dispose** of into suitable **bin**.
Dispose of any other disposable cloths found in the department into suitable bin.



- 2** Empty the contents of the storage bucket down the mop cleaning station sink **Clean** the **bucket** in **M1** Cleaning Detergent solution and store in suitable area till the following day.
