

# Promek VL223 Juice Dispenser



Operator to wear PVC or disposable apron and gloves when cleaning the machine. Ensure electrics do not get wet during cleaning – cloths to be well wrung out.



## DAILY

1

Switch off dispenser by pressing the green button and isolating from the power supply.

Drain the left-over juice into suitable storage container. Store in the fridge until clean completed or dispose of as required.

2

Remove the two top lids.  
Pull out the two stirrers from inside the machine.  
Clean these two removed items with M1 Cleaning Detergent followed by M2 Sanitiser. Allow to air dry.



3

Using M1 Cleaning Detergent solution, clean all internal areas of the juice tanks ensuring corners, tap, dispense well, stirrer clip and evaporator column are effectively cleaned.  
Drain the M1 Cleaning Detergent solution away.  
Using a dry cloth, remove any remaining debris and detergent solution.  
Repeat the above internal tank cleaning procedure with M2 Sanitiser solution ensuring corners, tap, dispense well, stirrer clip and evaporator column are covered.  
Drain tanks and allow to air dry.



4

Twist dispense taps anti-clockwise and lift off taps from the juice tanks.  
Remove the white rubber section from the exposed tap section.  
Remove the drip tray and drip tray lid.  
Clean the taps, removed sections and drip tray sections in M1 Cleaning Detergent solution followed by M2 Sanitiser solution. Allow to air dry.  
Wipe over all external surfaces of juice dispenser with M1 Cleaning Detergent solution.



## WEEKLY

5

In addition to the daily clean, remove tanks from the dispenser by lifting up off the evaporator unit, remove the rubber seal.  
Clean the exposed base area and tank undersides with M1 Cleaning Detergent solution.
