

Rack Conveyor Dishwashers




Operator to wear PVC or disposable apron and gloves when cleaning the machine.




Isolate from the electrical supply.
Empty the machine and **allow to cool**.
Pull the drain handles upwards to empty the pre-wash and wash tanks.





Remove the **pre-wash** and **wash tank arms** by rotating holding clips 90°. Care must be taken to not loosen or damage any parts.
Check that the **spray nozzles** and **arm end caps** are securely in place.
Note that the washer will not function correctly if any are missing or damaged. If any missing or damaged then report to department manager.
Clean the removed **arms** using a scourer and **M1** Cleaning Detergent solution.
Use a non-metallic implement to dislodge or prise out any material clogging the jets.

Remove the **rinse arms** from their spring plates and check that the jets are clear.
Clean the removed **arms** using a designated brush and **M1** Cleaning Detergent solution.

Unhook the **strip curtains** from either end of the dishwasher.
Remove filters and **plugs** and **clean** with **M1** Cleaning Detergent.
Clean the **curtains** using a scourer and **M1** Cleaning Detergent solution.

Using scourer and **M1** Cleaning Detergent solution **clean** all **internal and external surfaces** of the dishwasher, ensure backs of doors, water holding tanks and hard to reach areas are cleaned. Replace all cleaned removed parts.
Spray all **internal surfaces** with **M2** Sanitiser solution, **leave doors open** and allow all internal surfaces to air dry.
