Assessment

Assessment is through submission of a portfolio of evidence consisting of a series of workbooks and assignments; the latter being employment based. The workbook is submitted for marking and moderation and, if successful, the candidate is awarded with a Level 4 certificate in CIP by Highfield Awarding Body for Compliance. This course is broadly comparable to the level of study required for Level 4 NVQ / SVQ.
